Tom Collins

£4.95

Thought to be named after John Collins of Limmers Hotel, Hanover Square London circa 1880. A deliciously dry classic. Lemony and botanical. Perfect for sipping with friends.

Gin, Lemon Juice, Sugar Syrup, Club Soda.

English Rose

£5.95

The red and white royal rose was created not only to symbolise the marriage of Henry VII and Elizabeth of York but also the end of the War of the Roses. Celebrate our great royal history with this delightful blend of apricot and gin.

Gordon's Gin, Dry Vermouth, Apricot Brandy, Lemon Juice, Grenadine.

Black Tartan

£7.95

Some people might say that Drambuie on its own is the perfect drink. Said to have been given by Bonnie Prince Charlie to members of the Mackinnon clan who helped him to escape after the defeat at Culloden in 1746. Strong whisky flavours, delicately softened with a dash of Kahlua. Perfect with afters.

Johnnie Walker Black Whisky, Jamesons Irish Whisky, Drambuie, Kahlua.

Singapore Sling

£4.95

Created in one of the last bastions of the British Empire, Originally from the famous Raffles Hotel in Singapore served at the infamous long bar, a regular hang out of Noel Coward. A well balanced drink, with loads of flavours from refreshing pineapple to wonderfully dry juniper.

Cherry Brandy, Grenadine, Gin, Pineapple Juice, Lime Juice, Cherry & Pineapple Slice.

The Lord Nelson

£5.95

Horatio Nelson, 1st Viscount Nelson, 1st Duke of Bronté was said to have given away a barrel of Rum for all those sailors who helped defeat the invading Spaniards during the battle of Trafalgar in 1805. A smooth and mellow blend of rum and coffee, sweetened with scurvy busting lime juice and proper orange bitters.

Lambs Rum, Kahlua, Lime Juice, Angostura Bitters.

Charlie Chaplin

The Charlie Chaplin Cocktail was one of the premier drinks of the Waldorf-Astoria prior to 1920. However the man himself was a regular drinker in one of our Urban Inns 'The Old Ship' in Hackney. Though we cannot be certain that Mr Chaplin sipped this Cocktail between shows at the Hackney Empire!

Razmopolitan

£5.95

A good variation to the well known cosmopolitan. The combination of raspberry, lime and cranberry take this classic to a new level.

Chocolate Martini

No time for dessert? This awesome downer is sweet and sophisticated and sure to satisfy those chocolate cravings instantly!

Kir Royal

£7.95

Kir is named after Cannon Félix Kir, priest and hero of the French resistance who assisted many British and Allied troops during World War II. Raise your glass to Felix with this divine classic.

Crème de Cassis, Vintage Chapel Down.

Buck Fizz

£7.95

Created in 1921 for Captain Buckmaster at the Bucks Club, Central London. He asked for a Bellini and was given the unexpectedly delicious mix of sparkling wine and orange. The Buck's Fizz took London by storm.

Classic Champagne

Brown Sugar, Angostura Bitters, Vintage Chapel Down, 25ml Martell.





British Beers

All Meantime beers are long matured for maximum taste and flavour and have won numerous awards including 4 of the World's Top 50 Beers at the International Beer challenge. As one of only 2 remaining London brewers Meantime produce a broader range of both traditional British and World beer styles than any other brewery in the UK. All these beers are an ideal accompaniment to our British Food menus.

Union 330ml 4.9% ABV £3.30

A deep copper coloured beer with a firm fruity caramel aroma with a long crisp finish ideal to be drunk on its own or with salads or lighter dishes.

Pale Ale 330ml 4.7% ABV £3.85

Mix of spearmint, grass and hopsack aromas. Pale Ale should be drunk alongside foods such as cheese or our Handmade Pies.

Meantime Pilsner 330ml 4.7% ABV £3.85

A true Pilsner lager, crisp, bitter and refreshing. Stands up well with cheeses, hams, smoked meats and oily fish.

Wheat 330ml 5.0% ABV £3.85

A cloudy golden orange beer with a combination of banana, bubblegum, toffee and zesty aromas. A refreshing summer drink ideal for fish dishes.

Chocolate Ale 330ml 6.5% ABV £3.95

At first glance it is tempting to think of this as a dessert or digestif beer however, this is a good accompaniment to Casseroles and Stews.

Raspberry Grand Cru 330ml 6.5% ABV £3.95

A vibrant red colour with a shrill acidity on the palate with a refreshing tang that makes this beer a fanatatic digestif, ideal with chocolate based dessert, fresh fruit or soft cheeses.

London Stout 500ml 4.5% ABV £4.50

Derived from the original Stout Porters of the early 19th century. A velvet mouthfeel holds a rich caramel, molasses and nut roast which gives way to a gentle malt-bitter dryness. Ideal with duck, black pudding and any other rich dishes.





English Wine

Primrose Hill Lamberhurst Estate Bacchus 2006, Kent £29.00

Vibrantly aromatic with notes of elderflower, cut grass & gooseberry; on the palate, fresh citrus fruits & flowers mingle with flinty notes & refreshing acidity leading to a clean, dry conclusion.

Primrose Hill Tenterden Estate Rose, Kent £29.00

Deep vivid cherry-pink in colour. The nose is rich and ripe with red berry fruit aromas. Lots of cherry and damson fruit on the palate which is soft, round and full. Good texture and a dry finish.



English Sparkling Wine

Chapel Down Brut NV, Kent £6.50/£25.00

Lightly aromatic with a nutty edge to the nose from the ageing on lees. The palate is soft, delicate and gently fruity with apple, citrus and hawthorn.

Chapel Down Rose Brut NV, Kent £45.00

Characteristically pale and elegant with fine mousse and good persistence. The palate boasts soft, delicate red fruit flavours leading to a crisp, dry and focused finish.



Champagne

De Nauroy Brut NV £35.00

A top value Champagne made by Bruno Paillard one of the regions best producers. Fresh aperitif style with extended ageing.



Rose Wine

Lamberti Pinot Grigio Blush 2007, Veneto, Italy £4.95/£20.00

Subtle raspberry and strawberry notes adding to classic lemon and apple Pinot Grigio notes. A hint of juicy sweetness on the palate makes it all the more delicious.





White Wine

La Croix Blanc Vin de Pays de l'Aude 2006, France £3.65/£14.50

Intense nose of white flowers, juicy peaches and vanilla pods. The palate is full and well balanced with lively fruit and a refreshing finish.

San Rafael Sauvignon Blanc 2007, Casablanca, Chile £4.15/£16.50

Cool, crisp and fruity with soft tropical fruit notes of pineapple and passion fruit cut by citrusy lime and gooseberry finish.

Conti Rossi Garganega Pinot Grigio della Venezia IGT 2006 Italy £4.65/£16.50

Floral nose of jasmine and honeysuckle that is fresh and zesty on the palate. Good structure with a mineral finish.

Ceps du Sud Viognier, Languedoc, France £17.50

Wonderfully aromatic with peach and plump dried apricots on the nose. The palate is soft and fruity, with more stone fruit, a hint of spice and a fresh finish.

Thomas Mitchell Chardonnay 2006, SE Australia £19.00

Lemon yellow colour, with a citrus, fig and lemon nose. The palate is soft and complex showing ripe peach flavours and pronounced fruit character.

Spy Valley Sauvignon Blanc 2006, New Zealand £28.95

Classic NZ Sauvignon characters of gooseberry and asparagus, with ripe melon really delicately balanced and at the same time deliciously quaffable. A class act.

Coquille Chablis 2007, Burgundy, France £30.00

Brilliant, benchmark Chablis with clean, incisive Chardonnay fruit: No oak, just a pure Chablis style.





Red Wine

La Croix Rouge Vin de Pays de l'Aude 2006, France £3.65/£14.50

A classic Languedoc red, this has a soft fruity style with cherry and plum notes alongside herby thyme and rosemary flavours. Ripe tannins and just a hint of spice complete the picture.

Casa de Piedra Cabernet Sauvignon 2005, Lontue, Chile £4.15/£16.50

A powerful nose of red and black fruits, with a hint of dark chocolate. The palate is full-bodied, deliciously ripe and packed with fruit. A fine acid balance and tannin structure round it off superbly.

St Etalot Merlot 2006, Languedoc, France £4.65/£19.00

Elegant nose of ripe berries fruit. Well balanced, round and smooth on the palate.

Piropo Malbec, Argentina £18.95

Intense aromas of black stone fruit mingled with notes of chocolate & sweet spice from gentle oak aging. Blackberry & blackcurrant flavours lead to a long finish complemented by soft tannins.

Saam Mountain Vineyard Shiraz 2006, South Africa £18.95

A deep purple Shiraz, with a dark plum, black berry and spicy nose, typical of the Paarl region. The intensity of the fruit is carried on to the palate where it fills one's mouth with juicy tannins and ripe, dark, sweet fruit, rounded off by a dash of well managed oak. The aftertaste is long and really well integrated.

Villa Campobello Chianti Riserva 2003, Tuscany, Italy £21.50

Fruity nose with violets adding to the dark, spicy fruit aromas. Dry, savoury palate with black cherry and dark chocolate notes and spicy oak all playing a role.

Loredona Pinot Noir 2005, California, USA £31.50

The 2005 Loredona Pinot Noir features layers of sweet cherry, fresh raspberries, cola and nuts for a medium-bodied wine with a smooth finish.

Castillo de Clavijo Rioja Reserva 2003, La Rioja, Spain £29.00

Intense aromas with notes of spice, noble oak and vanilla. Flavourful, powerful, full-bodied and well-structured. Long finish with a good balance between oak and ripe fruit flavours.
